



## GBV Prevention Network Program Officer Job Opportunity

**Background:** Raising Voices is a non-profit organization based in Kampala, Uganda, working to prevent violence against women and children ([www.raisingvoices.org](http://www.raisingvoices.org)), through three main program areas: Practice, Learning, and Influencing. We are seeking a passionate individual with enthusiasm and commitment to fill the Program Officer position of the GBV Prevention Network. The GBV Prevention Network was founded and is coordinated by Raising Voices.

### **Purpose**

The GBV Prevention Network works to increase momentum for violence against women prevention by strengthening analysis, building connections and taking action to prevent VAW. The Network includes over 1000 individuals and organizations working on violence against women across the Horn, East and Southern Africa. With guidance from the GBV Prevention Network Program Manager, the Program Officer supports the planning, implementation and monitoring of the GBV Prevention Network activities. The Program Officer reports to the GBV Prevention Network Program Manager. This is a full-time position based in Kampala, Uganda.

### **Key Responsibilities**

1. Lead on implementation of selected feminist-informed activities of the Network through planning, implementation and monitoring.
2. Support and/or lead on the production of various creative and vibrant materials for use in feminist processes such as 16 Days of Activism, social media campaigns, etc
3. Facilitate or co-facilitate feminist processes for GBV Prevention Network members such as Get Moving! or the Rethink & Reenergize (R&R) processes.
4. Coordinate and oversee the social media platforms of the GBV Prevention Network
5. Provide technical assistance to members to conduct feminist processes with in their organizations
6. Complete timely workplans, reports, budgets and other needed documentation.
7. Ensure financial and other resources are utilized efficiently and effectively
8. Build and maintain productive relationships with members of the Network and other partners
9. Represent Raising Voices in national and regional forums and events.
10. Maintain a constructive and respectful relationships with all staff, members, partners and stakeholders; demonstrating values by example.

- At least 3 years' experience and exposure on VAW prevention.
- Ability to use social media platforms (Facebook, Twitter, etc).
